

Building and Campus Updates

I'm excited about the upgrades happening to our school. To highlight a few of the projects:

- The hallway near the boy's restroom received a fresh coat of paint.
- A new roof has been installed.
- Our gym floor was refinished and looks brand new.
- A lot of work has been done on the garden over the summer including the complete installation of the greenhouse and tool shed.
- With the addition of our new preschool program, a restroom has been installed within the classroom.
- The main student restrooms had an inspirational decorating take-over done to encourage students.
- Coming soon: solar panels will be installed to offset the cost of our power bill as we've been awarded a \$96,000 grant to fund solar array at our school.
